The legislation will raise Vermont's minimum wage from \$8.73 an hour, already almost a dollar above the federal minimum, to \$9.60 in 2016, \$10 in 2017 and \$10.50 in 2018. Beginning in 2019, the minimum wage will be indexed to inflation.

The funding, a significant increase over past years, is part of a new State Opioid Response Grant program created as part of the Leahy -negotiated 2018 Consolidated Appropriations Act signed into law this spring. Vermont's \$4 million grant is a direct result of language that Leahy fought for in the bill guaranteeing each state at least \$4 million to fight this deadly crisis.
