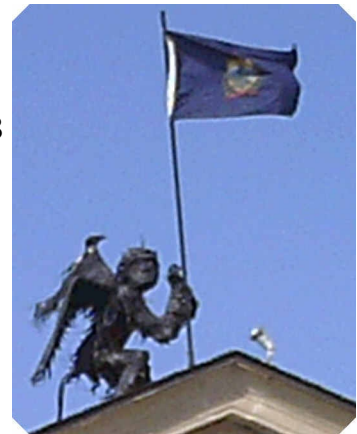

Approving gay civil unions didn't cost him his job

A popular governor for nearly a decade thanks to a solid record of tax cuts and environmental protection, Democrat Howard Dean seemed to have all the job security he needed. Then, last April, without fanfare, he signed into law a bill approved by the legislature making his the first state to legalize same-sex civil unions. A physician with a traditional family—he and his wife, internist Judy Steinberg, 47, have two school-age children—Dean had expected a negative reaction but not the angry “Take Back Vermont” campaign organized by residents who felt the state had no business condoning gay relationships. His Republican opponent, Ruth Dwyer, hoped to ride that groundswell of discontent into office but fell well short in the end. “Oh, sure, I would have had a much easier time if I hadn’t signed the bill,” concedes Dean. But he has no regrets about sanctioning civil unions and predicts that other states will soon follow suit.
